A New Season

Dear Neighbours:

You've likely noticed that demolition of the CAMH administration building on Queen Street West is well underway. Heavy demolition machinery - those large machines with claw-like appendages - began breaking it apart in mid-February starting from the west side.

Construction Schedule

The demolition of this building marks the beginning of the second phase in CAMH's Redevelopment Project. At the end of this phase, projected for mid-2012, there will be three new CAMH buildings. Demolition of the CAMH Administration Building will be completed by summer 2010. Construction of the three new CAMH buildings will begin in Spring 2010.

The new buildings

When we met in January, you had the opportunity to meet the developers of this phase, Carillion Health Solutions and got a sneak peek of what the new buildings will look like.

We also spoke briefly about the first non-CAMH use building which will go up right on Queen Street West. Contracts with the developer of this piece of land will be signed soon. Once the deal is sealed, they will be invited to speak with you about their plans for street-level retail and several floor of affordable rental housing units.

When this building, also expected to be ready by Fall 2012, stands side-by-side with the new CAMH buildings, it will be the first evidence of an emerging urban village - a welcoming, mixed-use space for the entire community with new public streets, parks and green hospital buildings alongside non-CAMH retail, commercial space, residences and cafes for everyone to enjoy.
